Held ~~AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SPENDING AUTHORITY OF THE MAYOR WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF RUSHSYLVANIA, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY~~

WHEREAS, Rushsylvania Village Council seeks to establish the authority of the mayor to enter into contracts or authorize expenditures without the approval of council for those contracts or expenditures with a maximum value of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) to provide for the more efficient operation of the Village of Rushsylvania; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Rushsylvania, County of Logan, State of Ohio as follows:

SECTION I: The Mayor shall be, and hereby is vested with authority to enter into contracts or make expenditures, without approval of council, for contracts or expenditures that are ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) or less in value. The Mayor shall notify the Village Council of any such contracts/expenditures within forty-eight (48) hours of entering into the contract or otherwise incurring the expenditure. The total amount of contracts/expenditures shall not exceed thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) per fiscal year without legislative approval by the Village Council. Any expenditures in excess of \$10,000.00 shall require legislative approval by the Village Council.

SECTION II: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure made necessary to protect the health, safety, and welfare of said Village, provide for its continuous uninterrupted services, and it shall, therefore, be in force and take effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the mayor.


